His highly effective programs garnered national attention and led to a White House invitation to be honored by the President of the United States.

In 2003, Ron Clark released the New York Times bestselling book, *The Essential 55*, which includes his 55 expectations of students — as well as all individuals — young and old. Ron's second book, *The Excellent 11*, was released in August 2004 and further captured the attention of parents, educators and students alike.

In addition to his many duties as an educator, Ron Clark is a much sought after keynote speaker. He shares the uncanny adventures he has had in the classroom and speaks of his experiences teaching in Harlem. Within his humorous and heartwarming stories, he delivers a message relevant to each of us. It is a message of hope, dedication and the never-say-never attitude required to achieve goals and dreams.

Salome Thomas-EL is a national education expert, award-winning teacher and principal, and bestselling author. He was a teacher and principal with the Philadelphia School District from 1987-2009. He received national acclaim as a teacher and chess coach at Vaux Middle School, where his students have gone on to win world recognition as Eight-Time National Chess Champions. Principal EL is a regular contributor on "The Dr. Oz Show" and the author of bestselling books, *I Choose to Stay*, about his Vaux Middle School experience, and *The Immortality of Influence*, which stresses the importance of mentoring, parenting and service to others. The Walt Disney Company optioned the movie rights to *I Choose to Stay*.

Thomas-EL speaks to groups across the country and frequently appears on C-SPAN, CNN, and NPR Radio. He is a graduate of East Stroudsburg University in Pennsylvania and is currently a doctoral candidate. Principal EL lives in Delaware County, PA with his wife and two young daughters. He has received the Marcus A. Foster Award as the outstanding School District Administrator in Philadelphia and the University of Pennsylvania's distinguished Martin Luther King Award. Principal EL was honored as a Reader's Digest Magazine, "Inspiring American Icon" and recently appeared on The Oprah Radio Network.
